



## **The New Zealand Flower and Garden Show 2017**

New Zealand has been without a major Flower Show since 2014, the Ellerslie team have come together to launch the New Zealand Flower and Garden Show to be held at The Trusts Arena, Waitakere in Auckland.

Established in 1994, the Ellerslie International Flower Show was one of New Zealand's iconic annual events, attracting a nationwide attendance, international media attention and crowds of more than 60,000 people.

To showcase the incredible talent of contemporary sculptors from New Zealand to the nationwide and international visitors at the New Zealand Flower and Garden Show. Through a variety of sculptural media produced by both emerging and established artists. The works will be set mainly within the dedicated sculpture exhibition area, with selected works placed throughout the garden show. Visitors can relax and walk amongst an exciting Sculpture Exhibition, which aligns with the outstanding high quality that is expected of the award winning exhibitors at the New Zealand Flower and Garden Show.

**Transportation/Installation/de-installation (of unsold works):** Is the responsibility of the artist. We have forklift facilities and a team to assist with your installation requirements – *Please note: These are not trained art handlers and are available for basic unloading/lifting and placing of sculptures only.* All works need to be robust for outdoor display. Works sold are the responsibility of the buyer in communication with the artist. Sold artworks must remain in place till the end of the show.

**Site Restrictions:** Posts/stakes are permitted for use. Due to the multipurpose use of the venue excavations are not permitted.

**Commission of sales:** All artwork exhibited is for sale. The New Zealand Flower and Garden Show will take 35% +GST commission on all sales. Any sales or commissions generated by introductions made through exposure at the New Zealand Flower and Garden Show, will also attract 35%+GST commission for a period of one month after the exhibition. We will rely on your honesty and integrity regarding any sales or commissions made.

**Payment of sales:** Artists will be notified of any works sold at the New Zealand Flower and Garden Show. The artist is then to invoice the show. The artist will be paid within seven days upon the shows receipt of the invoice.

**Insurance and security:** Insurance is the responsibility of the artist. The New Zealand Flower and Garden Show provides public liability insurance. The show is fenced with 24 hour security.

**Placement of artwork:** Is the discretion of the Curator and the New Zealand Flower and Garden Show.

**Use of images:** The New Zealand Flower and Garden Show retains the rights to reproduce any images submitted for marketing and catalogue use.

**Tickets to the show:** All artists will receive two complimentary tickets to the New Zealand Flower and Garden Show. If any more tickets for potential clients are required please contact the Curator.
